UPDATE ON PARKING SPACE RENTAL

Have you noticed many cars parked around the perimeter of our parking lot on weekdays? Who owns these cars? People working in our neighbourhood - in construction, government, businesses - who find that \$75 a month for a safe, reliable, not-ever-going-to-be-ticketed-or-towed parking space is so much more convenient (and cheaper) than a parking ticket or having to move your vehicle every few hours throughout the working day. St. Mary's rents out 30 spots, selected so as not to interfere with people coming to daily mass, the adoration chapel, etc. And we have a waiting list for spaces that become available. Clearly, we're offering a service much appreciated.

The benefit to our parish is revenue: income for the first six months of 2018 from parking permits is almost \$13,000.

We could not have done this without a great deal of preparatory work, permission from the Archdiocese, established pre-authorized debit, advertisements throughout the neighbourhood and friendly office staff to welcome interested parkers and execute a organized procedure. All-in-all, a blessing to everybody.
